## Holistic Care in Patients with Acute Myocardial Infarction: From Acute Management to Secondary Prevention

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Holistic health is a concept in medical practice upholding that all aspects of people's needs, psychological, physical and social should be taken into account and seen as a whole. For patients presented as acute myocardial infarction, adherence to guideline suggetions including shortening door-to-balloon time for ST-elevation myocardial infarction, early intervention for high risk NSTEMI, and acute medications including aspirin, clopidogrel and beta-blocker are shown to decrease mortality rate. Further health education during hospital stay for patient and family including diet control, smoking cessation, drug with cardiac rehabilitation were also recommended. by american college of cardiology/ american heart association (ACC/AHA) guidlines. By Crusade Study, the higher adherence rate to acute and discharge medications, the lower 1 year mortality. With holistic care, the quality of life and patient survial got improved.
