He was born on february 1, 1945 in Papendrecht. He studied physics and did his PhD work at the Technical University Delft. He got his PhD in 1971. From 1971 to 1974 he worked in the department Radiotherapy and Nuclear Medicine of the St Radboud hospital Nijmegen. From 1974 to 1985 he worked at the department Medical Informatics of the Free University Amsterdam.

In 1985 he was appointed professor in Medical Informatics at the University Maastricht. From 1991 to 2005 he was also is part-time professor at the Technical University Eindhoven. In 2004 he was appointed professor in Medical Informatics at AMC-UvA in Amsterdam

Publications and PhD supervision

Arie Hasman published more than 400 publications and was authors of a number of books. He has researched in the areas of databases, signal processing, image processing, decision support systems and education. He was supervisor of 37 PhD candidates.
