Peter Crome MD PhD FRCP FFPM

Peter qualified from King's College Hospital Medical School in 1970. After junior posts in South East London he passed his MRCP whilst a Medical Registrar at Bromley Hospital. He then worked at Guy's Hospital where he obtained his MD degree for a thesis on tricyclic antidepressant poisoning. He trained in general and geriatric medicine and in clinical pharmacology at Guy's and St Helen's Hospital Hastings (Dr. Bobbie Irvine). He spent 10 years as a Consultant at Orpington Hospital followed by 3 years as a Senior Lecturer at Kings. He moved to Keele as Professor of Geriatric Medicine in 1994.

He has been President of the Section of Geriatrics and Gerontology at the RSM and is President-Elect of the BGS. He also chairs the Geriatrics Committee of the Royal College of Physicians of London.

His present clinical work is divided between a community hospital and memory clinics. His research focuses on stroke, dementia and clinical pharmacology. He directs the Keele MSc in Geriatric Medicine. At Keele has served as Head (Dean) of the Medical School and he is presently Deputy Head and Head of Postgraduate Medicine. He is also a Non-Executive Director of the Shropshire and Staffordshire Strategic Health Authority
